PRE-ENTRY PREPARATION

- [Click here](#) if you want to pay your 1 time \$25 entry fee (per station) now. If not, you will have an opportunity later

CREATE AN ACCOUNT / LOGGING IN

- [Click Here](#) to Create Your Account. **You will only need to do this once** for 2025-2026 AWARDS SEASON. Last year's accounts were deleted. You can use the same information when you create your account for this year
- [Click Here](#) to log in anytime you want to add another entry. Select the tab called "Log In" to log into the site once you have created your account.

ENTRY FORM

- [Click Here](#) to open the Entry Form. The form will walk you through the entire process.
- Note: Every time you submit an entry, a copy of your entry form will be sent to your **email. That is your only copy.** Each form will have a button that allows you to go back in and edit any part of your entry.

MEDIA

- Every entry allows up to 4 media files of any type. Make sure you have read the [Rules and Criteria](#)

VIDEO: Submit a YouTube link to the video you want to submit. You must make sure this video is made **public.**

IMAGE: Any image either a JPG or PNG file

AUDIO: Any audio file formatted as an MP3 file

DOCUMENT: Any document formatted as a PDF file
